CLERK OF THE COURT:-

THIS MATTER having come before this Court procedurally upon the DEMAND of the Defendant for mootness, Plaintiff's failure to prosecute herein and having known to this Court the mandatory disclosure obligation pursuant under Brady v. Maryland 373 U.S.83 (1963) and United States v. Bagley, 473 U.S. 667, 682 (1985) for the mandatory dismissal of this action with prejudice pursuant to Federal Rule 5(see attached).

[State] will enter into agreements with appropriate courts, law enforcement officials, such as district attorneys, attorneys general, and similar public attorneys and prosecutors and corrections officials, pursuant to 45 CFR §302.34 & 303.107.

The Supremacy Clause forbids [State] courts to dissociate themselves from federal law because of disagreement with its content or a refusal to recognize the superior authority of its source. See, Howlett v. Rose, 496 U.S. 356 (1990); Mondou vs. New York, N.H. & H.R. Co., 223 U. S. 1, 223 U. S. 57.

United States Supreme Court unanimously held that [State] courts cannot issue rulings that contradict the decisions of federal courts to have the final power to decide cases

arising under the Constitution and federal statutes, and that the [States] do not have the power to overturn those decisions. See, *Ableman vs. Booth*, 62 U.S. (21 Howlett.) 506 (1859).

THIS COURT having fully reviewed Defendant's submissions of court papers and finding no answers to agreements not appearing in the record thereof to *Rule 5*, Plaintiff is otherwise being fully advised, now and furthermore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that this matter shall be dismissed with prejudice. All parties to herein action are to bear their own costs and fees.
